The adult with the most points overall receives a certificate and the **BT SHOW CUP FOR ADULTS.**

A CHILD must be 12 years old or younger and will receive a participation certificate.

CLASS 19: VINEGAR CAKE RECIPE (*Victory Cookbook by Marguerite Patten*)

6oz Self raising flour
3oz margarine
3oz sugar
¼ pt. milk
1 tablespoon vinegar
½ teaspoon bicarbonate of soda
3 – 4oz mixed dried fruit

METHOD

1. Cream the margarine and sugar in a bowl
2. Pour the milk into a large bowl and add the vinegar and the bicarbonate of soda, the mixture will rise and froth in the bowl.
3. Sift the flour into the vinegar liquid.
4. Blend the flour and vinegar mix into the creamed margarine and sugar.
5. Add the dried fruit and stir in.
6. Put into a greased and floured 7 inch cake tin.
7. Bake in a moderate oven for 1 hour.
